## Tool 4 - Supporting older carers, spheres of support

This tool sets out ways of supporting older carers identified in pilots around the country. You can use it to consider how your service accesses or provides support for older carers, particularly when they are isolated and when they become bereaved.

Falls prevention advice; transport assistance; respite sitting service; referral to handy person scheme; seated exercise; health trainer; Time 4 You; I & A, GPs; district nurse teams; occupational therapist; Stroke Association; Christmas hamper scheme.

Information and advice

Welfare benefits check; Disability benefits advice; Pension credit advice; Attendance Allowance applications; Welfare benefit appeals; Carers grant applications; Council Tax advice; care charges, Appointeeship; Power of Attorney; signposting to external services; health care complaint; residential care charges; Advanced Directives and care planning; volunteering opportunities.

**Emotional** 

Telephone support; home visits; befriending; coffee morning groups; bereavement support groups; bereavement support 1:1; introduction to social groups; Christmas lunch; advocacy.
